#### Privacy Notice - Data Protection Act 1998

We, **Nicol Mere Primary School** are a data controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect personal information from you about your child, and may receive information about your child from their previous school and the Learning Records Service. We hold this personal data to:

- Support your child's learning;
- Monitor and report on your child's progress;
- Provide appropriate pastoral care, and
- Assess how well we are doing.

Information about your child that we hold includes contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information<sup>1</sup> and personal characteristics such as your child's ethnic group, any special educational needs your child may have and relevant medical information.

You should be aware that from time to time, the school will choose to share your child's data with organisations external to the school, often for operational reasons. For example, pupil information may need to be shared with the school photographer or the operator of the school dinner money or library systems.

We are also required by law to pass some information about your child to our Local Authority (LA) and the Department for Education.
