



Dojo itself has been a good direct message service to communicate and send in photos etc to teachers to support Abigail's learning journey. Jacob took a while to settle into school life however he was given a lot of support to try and make his transition as easy as possible. Jacob didn't respond to Dojo points but as a parent it is a very useful system especially for message and updates.

Suggestions from parents:

You Said	We Said
Morning workshops are hard for working parents to attend	We are very aware of working parents however there is a limit of how many and when workshops can be run. Some workshops are run after school, however we find that morning workshops seem to be better attended. We will continue to provide workshops before and after school to try and ensure as many parents as possible get a change to attend some of the workshops.
I don't get Dojo. We saw the points coming through but comments like 'good work' did really help me understand what she had done. Some hiccups with points deducted too.	The whole school is trialling Dojo this year. We have already made some changes to make the rewards and sanctions more specific. Parents will be asked to give feedback on the reward system at the end of the year.
'2 Simple' is a lovely idea however it may not be as 'simple' as the name suggest. The layout and terminology is a bit baffling to someone who does not have any experience in education.	Reception will run a workshop on '2 Simple' to help parents navigate and relate the terminology and acronyms used to the information help sheets given out at the beginning of the year. If anyone is ever in doubt or has any questions, please speak to the class teacher before or after school and they will be happy to help.
